G.S.R. 159 .- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 65 read with section 37 of the Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984 (Central Act No. 52 of 1984), the State Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan State Veterinary Council Rules, 1988, namely :-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the Rajasthan State Veterinary Council (Amendment) Rules, 2016.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Amendment of rule 3.- In rule 3 of the Rajasthan State Veterinary Council Rules, 1988, hereinafter referred to as the said rules,-

(a) the existing sub-rule (14) shall be substituted by the following, namely :-

"14. Voting.- (i) if the number of duly nominated candidates for election does not exceed the number of members to be elected, the Returing Officer shall forthwith declare such candidates duly elected. If the number of such candidates exceed the number of members to be elected, the Returning Officer shall fix a Period of not exceeding seven days for election of members through onlile voting.

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- (ii) For online voting, the eligible voter has to login with Registered Veterinary Practitioner number. After login. he will receive a onetime password (OTP) on his mobile number. On entering such onetime password (OTP) the voter will be able to see the list of contesting candidates and then he may vote by ticking (\checkmark) as many candidates as there are seats to be filled by the election. After voting, voter shall get an acknowldgement that he has completed the voting process successfully. After voting voter shall be automatically logged out and re-vote shall not be possible." ';
- (b) the existing sub-rule (15) shall be deleted.;
- (c) the existing sub-rule (16) shall be deleted.;
- (d) the existing sub-rule (17) shall be substituted by the following, namely :-

"(17) **Counting of votes.-** (i) The Returning Officer shall, on the date and time fixed by him for this purpose, enter the password and get the number of votes received by each contesting candidate.

(ii) Any contesting candidate or his representative duly authorized in writing by him may remain present in person to watch the process of counting.";

(e) The existing sub-rule (18) shall be substituted by the following, namely :-

"(18) **Declaration of result** .- (i) The Returning Officer shall drew up a list of candidates in order of highest votes polled and declare the candidates elected, in that order according to the number of seats to be filled up.

(ii) When there is equality of votes among any two or more candidates, then the candidate who shall be deemed to have been elected shall be determined by lots to be drawn by the Returning Officer or any other officer authorized by him in such manner as he may determine.

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- (iii) The Returning Officer shall, as soon as the result is declared inform each successful candidate of his being elected to the State Council.
- (iv) if any candidate declared elected under clause (i) above refuses to act as member, then in the place of that candidate one of the remaining unsuccessful candidates to whom the nest largest number of votes have been polled, shall be deemed to have been elected and the same procedure shall be adopted as often as vacancy is caused in this way,"; and
- (f) The existing sub-rule (19) shall be substituted by the following, namely:-

"(19) **Election documents.-** After declaration of result the Returning Officer shall Preserve all the documents relating to election for a period of six months and shal not destroy without the previous sanction of the Government."
